D.I.T. – Deaf Institute of Theology...

The Office of the Secretary for Deaf Ministry along with our Synod has authorized a SPECIAL School (institute) for all deaf people. Both men and women are needed to apply for course credits. The cost is a one time application fee of \$25 along with \$40 per class from students, \$30 per class from sponsoring congregation, and \$30 from your district. There are a total of 8 levels with the top 3 levels reserved for those deaf men who wish to become pastors, themselves. This is a whole new exciting way of preparing and hopefully for doing ministry among the deaf. This new way of doing ministry puts all the tools for doing God's work into the hands of the deaf where it belongs. Deaf ministry among the deaf, for the deaf, by the deaf, with the help of God!



Cruise to Alaska...







During the worship service on Sunday, June 12, 2005 Kathy Morris, Parish Ministry Consultant for Bethesda Lutheran Homes and Services, Inc. recognized Pastor Gary Lawson and Christ Deaf Lutheran Church as partnership in ministry with Bethesda Lutheran Homes and Services, Inc. and presented Pastor Lawson with Bethesda's Mission Statement.

Bethesda's Mission Statement "To teach and share Christ's love while providing supports and services for people with developmental disabilities."

Kathy spoke to the congregation about the mission and ministry of Bethesda and the relationship and partnership Bethesda has with Pastor Gary Lawson as he service as our Partner Pastor with Kelly Hunter and Scarlet Bradley, both were deaf born deaf and served as acolytes and member of the Praise Choir.
