From the Pastoral Advisor



Greetings from Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada!

It has become almost commonplace to note that Canada is not the nation it once was. You, fellow American neighbours may

have been aware of the challenging change Canadians have faced politically, socially, and militarily up to date after one century five decades (150 years) of peace. The fact is, most Canadians were shocked and stunned by an Islamic-converted Canadian who shot an innocent soldier in front of Parliament Hill several days ago. Even, a number of young Muslim Canadians have sneaked to Middle East to join the militant and barbaric Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) army against the Christians, Kurds, and several different Islamic sects like Sunni and Shiites. The Canadian government has begun to revoke passports and to ban the returning Canadian Muslims home. Nevertheless, Christians in Canada are learning what it means to suffer for Christ. 

ILDA Treasurer Report by Patrick R. Sell, Treasurer Pro Tem

The money collected for ILDA mission projects 2013-2015 is now \$ 26,888.78 as of September 30, 2014. This is about 94% of the total needed. Three projects have met their goal. Two more to go. There are 7 months left to raise our goal of \$ 28,500. Deadline for donations is May 31, 2015.
