Right Hand Award nomination rules

The deadline for the Uriel C. Jones Memorial Right Hand Award to be given out at the Dearborn, Michigan convention is fast approaching.

The rules for nomination are:

- 1. The award is given to one deaf person who is a member of an LCMS congregation and has a record of continuous, exceptional and meritorious Christ service within his/her church and/or community. Recipient may be of either sex (male or female).
- 2. Clergy, full or part-time lay ministers and current ILDA Board members are not eligible.
- 3. Congregations may nominate a person from their own congregation, field or another congregation elsewhere during a formal voters assembly. The nomination form is to be filled out, signed and dated and returned to the Right Hand Award Chairperson (see below).
- 4. Individuals may not nominate themselves for the Right Hand Award.
- 5. Deadline for nomination form(s) to be returned is June 5, 2024.

for everyone. The registration for the convention will need to be completed by the 15th of June 2024 to plan for everything in place. That registration and all the related information can be found at www.deafjesus.org/ilda/2024.

Thursday, July 11th, the registration at the hotel will be open from 1 p.m. – 5 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. dinner on your own. There are several

restaurants near the hotel or you can have your dinner right at the hotel too. This information will be announced through our Facebook page soon.
